

Cremation Memorial Trees

How it Works

1. Determine if a memorial tree is right for you



A memorial tree can be a powerful & meaningful way to honor your loved one and tend to your grief. Take some time to decide if you have access to private property that is suitable for a tree and if you are committed to providing daily care and tending to a tree for many years to come.

2. Complete your on-site tree consultation



An arborist & ceremonialist will visit your property to help you select the species of tree that will have the best chance of thriving for years to come, and to learn a bit more about your loved one in order to honor them in the most loving way.

3. Schedule the memorial tree planting ceremony

We'll work with you to schedule a date to plant your tree. Typically this is done between March - May or September - November. A ceremonialist will conduct a brief ceremony on the chosen date during the planting, and you may invite your loved ones to be a part of this special occasion.

4. Attend the tree planting ceremony



5. Care for the tree



Participating in the planting ceremony is a beautiful way to foster healing. The placement takes 1-2 hours and includes digging the site, placing the ashes or stones with the tree, and placing the sapling into the earth. A ceremonialist will honor your loved one with poems, readings, songs, and/or writing notes to place with the tree.

We'll provide you with detailed instructions to care for your tree. The arborist will also conduct a follow-up visit around six months after planting to check on the health of your tree. Our team will be available to provide ongoing support and recommendations as you care for the tree for years to come.

Anniversary Ceremony - \$450

A ceremonialist will return to your tree planting site on the anniversary of the planting or another special date, such as your loved one's birthday, to guide you through an anniversary ceremony to keep your loved one's memory alive.

Our Commitment to Healthy Trees

We are committed to bringing you the only highest-quality trees to honor your loved one. The trees we provide are promised to arrive to you in the best possible condition. While nature is unpredictable and often has a plan of her own, we will do everything possible to maximize the lifespan of each cremation memorial tree.

If the following conditions are met, we will guarantee the life and health of the tree for up to 2 years and replace it at no charge if it does not take.

- If the location is a private residence or other private property where placement, access to water, and protection from vandalism is established.
- If tree species, selection, and location are scouted by our experts.
- If the planting process is facilitated by the Be a Tree Cremation team.
- If all care instructions have been followed appropriately.

Force majeure: Other extreme circumstances such as fire, extreme drought, insect infestations, tornadoes, snow storms, ice storms, wind storms, or lighting also occur in nature. In these situations, we will evaluate the circumstances and work with you to move or re-establish the cremation memorial tree.
